

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INTRODUCTION

The online Spanish courses of the Instituto Cervantes have been developed in accordance with Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), from level A1 to C1.

It is composed of 16 courses and 48 topics, supported by teaching resources, videos, and interactive exercises. With these tools the student will be able to learn Spanish at any time and place using a mobile phone, and do so in an effective, fun and independent way.




COURSES

The courses will take you through a complete set of activities at the chosen level.

There are 16 different courses, each with a duration of 30 hours, and each containing resources and activities designed with the most modern techniques for Spanish learning.

Following the independent style of the course, its user will receive academic notifications to demonstrate the level reached upon the completion of over 80% of the course contents



TOPICS

The resources in the platform offer students the possibility of studying Spanish through the concrete units we call topics.

There are 48 different topics, designed for users who have more concrete communicational objectives and a shorter timeframe in which to learn Spanish.

Each topic has a duration of 10 hours, within which users follow a specific path through their chosen content.



AVE Global. Topic 11. Intermediate B1.4 The environment. City and countryside	Learning to express your opinion; to give advice and make recommendations; to express necessity or urgency. Learning the territorial division of Spain and other Spanish speaking countries.
AVE Global. Topic 12. Intermediate B1.4 Learning languages. Intercultural awareness	Learning to speak about advantages and disadvantages; getting to know the DELE Spanish certificates; Learning the different languages spoken in Spain and Latin America; developing competence
